MOBILE DEVICE POLICY

Mobile devices must be kept in Golf Mode Setting at all times at the KPMG Women's PGA Championship:

- Set device to silent or vibrate, including but not limited to, ringer and notifications/alerts, with the camera flash turned off.
- Incoming and outgoing calls may only be made or received farther than 100 yards of competition.
- Text, email, social posting and other data use is allowed on the golf course at any location providing players are not in position and about to play their shots.
- Mobile device photography, as well as audio and video capturing, is allowed in all areas during Practice Rounds (Tuesday & Wednesday).
- During Championship Rounds (Thursday – Sunday), photography, audio and video recording is prohibited anywhere within 100 yards of competition or when requested by players, caddies, marshals, volunteers, security or Championship staff and officials.

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

The items listed below are strictly prohibited on the grounds of Kemper Lakes Golf Club. All items are subject to be searched upon entering the Championship.

- **Backpacks of any size and drawstring bags.** Prohibited bags will NOT be accepted or stored on site.
- Bags larger than 10" x 10" x 10" in their natural state, with the exception of folding chair bags. Chair must be removed from bag at security check point.
- Bags larger than 10" x 10" x 10" sold in The Championship Shops will be tagged as prohibited for re-admission.
- Personal electronics such as computers, laptops or tablets
- Drones, hoverboards, laser pointers, or selfie sticks
- All oversized chairs with wide arm rests (portable folding canvas chairs are permitted). Carry bags will be searched prior to entry.
- Weapons of any kind (regardless of permit), including pocket knives
- Buckets, ladders, milk crates, or stools
- Banners, posters, or signs
- Any materials with unauthorized advertising or promotion
- Coolers
- Bicycles
- Golf Clubs
- Food (except in limited quantities for medical, dietary or infant purposes)
- Alcohol
- Beverages (one unopened, sealed bottle of water per spectator is permitted)
- Other items deemed inappropriate or dangerous by Championship security in their sole discretion.

Please leave all prohibited items in your vehicle as they will not be permitted at the KPMG Women's PGA Championship.

CONDUCT, CUSTOMS AND ETIQUETTE

Please be advised of the following standards of conduct and etiquette:

- Everyone is requested to display traditional customs of etiquette, decorum and behavior, and to obey all Championship policies, signs and verbal instructions of Championship Officials. Protests of any type are forbidden.
- For the safety of everyone and in keeping with policy established at major sporting events, running is considered to be unacceptable behavior.
- Although cheering and positive gallery responses to great play are encouraged, unsolicited and consistent calls from the gallery are prohibited.
- Please stay behind the gallery ropes and cooperate with the marshals.
- Please kneel or sit if you are in the front row and remain still throughout each shot.

GENERAL SPECTATOR INFORMATION

ADMISSION POLICY

A ticket, once scanned, will no longer gain admission to the Championship grounds. If you plan to return to Kemper Lakes the same day, please have security stamp your hand at one of the spectator entrances. You will only be able to return to the grounds with a scanned ticket and a hand stamp. The only exception is when the Weather Warning signs have been posted. In this situation, a hand stamp will not be required for re-entry to the Championship. Please display your ticket in plain view at all times as security personnel will not allow admission to the Championship for individuals without appropriate credentials.

JUNIOR ADMISSION POLICY

As part of the Championship's mission to grow interest and participation in the game of golf, the Championship is excited to offer up to four (4) complimentary junior admissions with every paid adult ticket. Junior admissions apply to youth age 17 and under, and may be obtained at the Admissions Office located at the Main Spectator Entrance on the day of entry. Please note, Junior tickets do not grant access into private hospitality venues.

MILITARY ADMISSION POLICY

To honor the men and women who serve our country in the Armed Forces, the Championship is pleased to offer Active Duty, Retired, Reserve, National Guard, Veterans, and their accompanying guest (limit one) complimentary daily grounds access to the Championship. Upon arrival, military personnel must go to the Admissions Office at the Main Spectator Entrance to present their Military ID to exchange for daily grounds tickets. Please note, these tickets cannot be upgraded to alternative venues, but are eligible for the Junior Admission policy.

PHOTOS & AUTOGRAPH POLICY

Cameras are only allowed at Kemper Lakes Golf Club during Practice Rounds on Tuesday and Wednesday, and are not permitted on-site during Championship Rounds, Thursday through Sunday. Autographs may be requested and given at the contestants' convenience at the Practice Range and Putting Green during Practice Rounds only. Please consult the Mobile Device Policy for guidelines regarding mobile device photo, audio, and video capturing while on-course.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR SPECTATORS

Please observe the Leader Boards and Thru Boards for the Weather Warning Sign which will appear when inclement weather is approaching the site. When the signs appear, spectators are advised to take precautions and seek shelter PRIOR to play being suspended. If the sirens sound, seek shelter immediately.

CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF SHOP

TRANSPORTATION

Metra

Utilizing the two Metra lines located adjacent to the General Public parking lot at Prairie Crossing on Milwaukee District North (MD-N), and North Central Service (NCS) is a convenient way to arrive and depart from the Championship. The MD-N line runs seven days a week, while the NCS only runs on weekdays, so please plan accordingly. Complimentary shuttles will be at the Metra stops for train arrival and departures. ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Designated accessible parking for those requiring lift-equipped transportation to the course will be provided. ADA accessible parking will be at Lot B (Lake Zurich High School), 300 Church St, Lake Zurich, IL 60047. FROM CHICAGO & POINTS SOUTH:

- Head North on I-90/I-94
- Follow signs to merge onto I-94
- Take Exit 29 for I-94 W toward Milwaukee
- Continue on I-94 W
- Take Exit for Buckley Rd/IL-137
- Turn left onto Buckley Rd/IL-137
- Turn left onto Midlothian Rd
- Follow signs for Lot GP

FROM POINTS EAST:

- Take Buckley Rd/IL-137
- Turn left onto Midlothian Rd
- Follow signs for Lot GP

FROM POINTS WEST:

- Take IL-120 E/Rand Rd

TAXI, LIMOUSINE, & CAR SERVICE INFORMATION

All spectators arriving by taxi, limousine, or car service should plan to be dropped off and picked up at the General Public parking lot located at Lake County Fairgrounds, 1060 E Peterson Rd, Grayslake, IL 60030. Please note: there will not be a location on-site at Kemper Lakes Golf Club for drop-offs or pick-ups, unless you have the pre-distributed proper parking credential that allows access to a designated lot.

RIDESHARE

All spectators using rideshare services, such as Uber or Lyft, will be dropped off and picked up at designated spots on-site in Lot A. There will be a waiting area nearby the designated rideshare spots to request a vehicle for pick-up. Destinations set at Kemper Lakes Golf Club will redirect to the designated pick-up/drop-off location. A reminder, due to safety concerns, there are no walk-ins to the Championship. Please note this is NOT a drop-off or pick-up location for taxis, limousines, or other car services.
